

Education Trial – Get Familiar with Studies at the University of Applied

During a two-week of education trial, you will receive guidance and familiarize yourself with the contents of a degree programme of your interest.

You can follow the lessons and discuss with teachers and study counsellors. The teaching language is Finnish or English, depending on the degree programme. You have to agree on the trial beforehand with the TE Office. Becoming a Student at the University of Applied Sciences

After the trial, you can apply to become a student at the University of Applied Sciences during the application period, or start your studies in the Open UAS. Ask the study counsellor for more information about the open path studies, by which you can also apply for degree student status at the University of Applied Sciences.
